Wire Transfer Instructions - Incoming and Outgoing Wires

Outgoing Wires

Domestic (U.S.)

- The name and address of the recipient
- The recipient's account and routing number
- The name of the recipient's bank
- The address of the recipient's bank
- Purpose for the wire transfer

International

- The name, address, and country of the recipient
- The recipient's account and SWIFT Code or IBAN number
- The name of the recipient's bank
- The address and country of the recipient's bank
- Any other applicable instructions
- Purpose for the wire transfer

Please Note: The cutoff time for same-day wire transfers is 2 pm Mon-Fri, requests received after this time or on Saturdays will be processed on the next business day.

Incoming Wires

To receive an incoming wire transfer to your account, please provide the following information to the individual or business that is sending the wire:

- The name on your account as it appears on your statement
- Your full account number
- Your address
- Bank Name: NextMark Credit Union
- Bank Address: 4201 Member's Way, Fairfax, VA 22030
- ABA/Routing #: 256078501
 - Currently, NextMark Credit Union does not have a SWIFT code. To receive international incoming wire transfers into a NextMark account, the originating financial institution must also utilize an intermediary bank to process the wire transfer to NextMark.

Please Note: The cutoff time for same-day wire transfers is 2 pm Mon-Fri, requests received after this time or on Saturdays will be processed on the next business day.
